Pastoral Sabbatical

Dixie and I will be away for our first Pastoral Sabbatical in January and February. We have been ministering for over 40 years, and have never before taken a sabbatical. I have pastored New Life church for 10 ½ years and have served as a senior pastor since 1973. This will be a tenure-related sabbatical which serves as a preventative measure to help pastors and their families avoid burn-out. This is an extended time away from job responsibilities for the purpose of reflection, renewal, and revitalization. This intentional ministry was recommended by Jerry Ferguson, District Superintendent, two years ago at the pastoral renewal time. I will be preaching on January 2, and return Sunday, March 6.

- It is a time to be stimulated by new learning

Sabbaticals are Biblical

The concept is deeply rooted in Scripture. The term comes from the Old Testament idea of "Sabbath," meaning "rest." In establishing the Sabbath covenant, God stipulated that the people were to work six days and rest on the seventh (Exodus 16:26). God also instituted what was called the "Sabbath year." The people were to work the land for six years and on the seventh they were to rest from their labor in the field (Leviticus 25:3,4). The Sabbath provided a time of recovery for both the people and the land.

Also, as one reflects on the life and ministry of Jesus, it becomes apparent that He was a proponent of the sabbatical concept. On more than one occasion He withdrew from the constraining pressures of ministry, going to the mountains and desert places where he could find rest and spiritual solitude (Matthew 5:1; 14:23). With His encouragement and admonition, His disciples followed the same pattern (Mark 6:31). The idea of sabbatical comes from the Bible.

Our Plan

The sabbatical will emphasize rest and renewal. There should be a total disconnection from the local church except for periodic exchange of progress reports and contact in case of emergencies. You will be able to call our Associate Pastor Jim Real for day-to-day issues. Much of the sabbatical will be taken away from Porter Ranch. We will drive to Washington, taking time along the way to visit churches and ministries. We will visit with our son and family in Seattle. In February, Jim Real & I will attend the Church of the Nazarene M11 Pastors Conference in Louisville, KY. Rev. Mike Shipman will preach in January, Dr. Robin Smith in February, and Rev. Jim Real on February 27. Please pray for us during this time!
